**SYNOPSIS OF FACTS:**

Subject attended Communist meetings about three years ago, having invited Informant T-1 who also attended. Informant T-2 reports subject held Communist meetings at his home and passed out Communist literature on the Army project to fellow workers. Mail cover placed with negative results.
