Subject born Brenham, Texas, 10/2/12, professor at California Institute of Technology, Pasadena, and in charge of Gal-Cit Project No. 1 of U.S. Army Air Corps. Subject attended Communist meetings about three years ago, having invited Informant T-1 who also attended. Informant T-2 reports subject held Communist meetings at his home and passed out Communist literature on the Army project to fellow workers. Mail cover placed with negative results.
